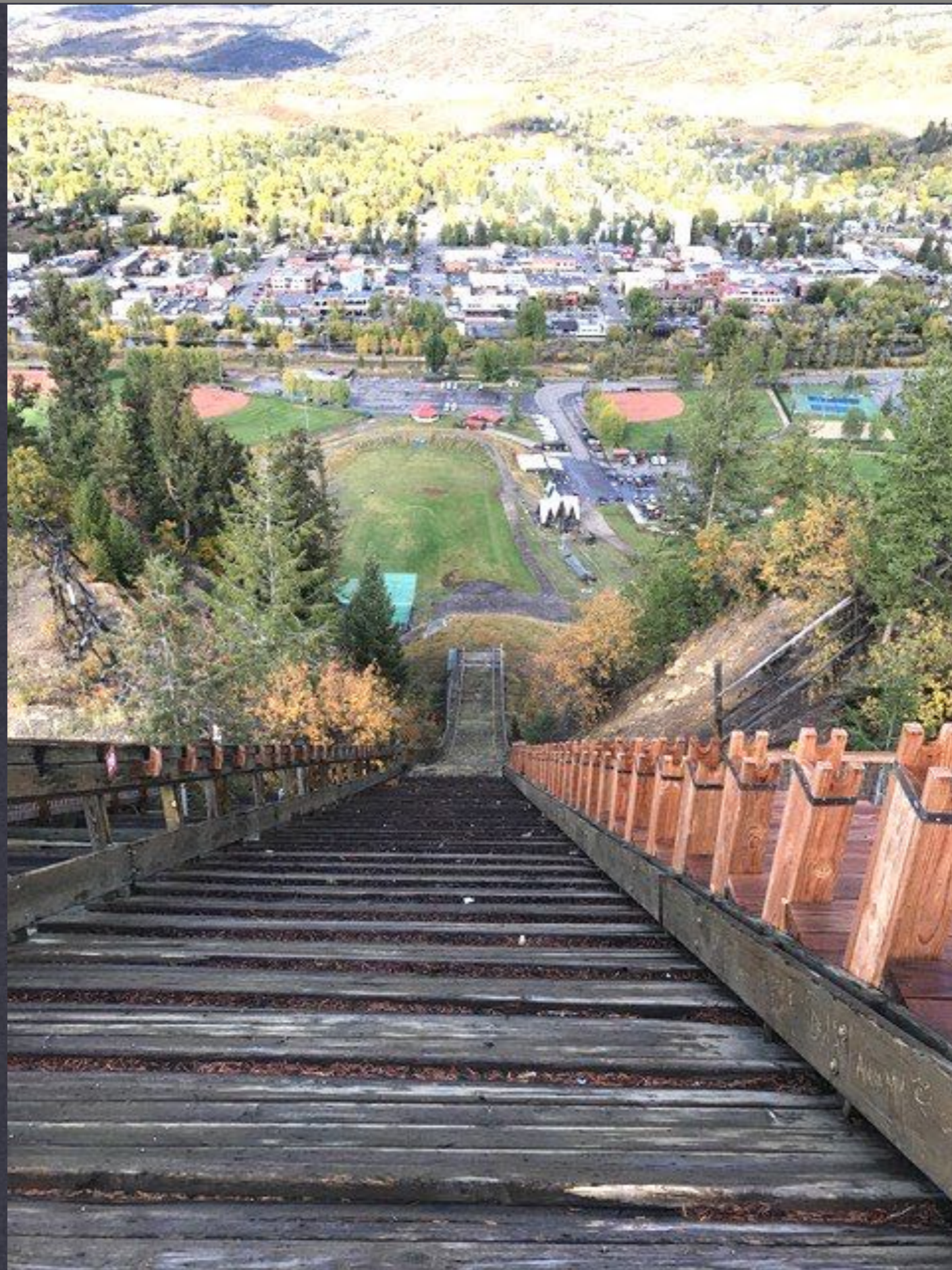



THE LORD FIGHTS

“And the **Lord** threw them into a panic before Israel, who **struck them** with a great blow at Gibeon and **chased them** by the way of the ascent of Beth-horon and **struck them** as far as Azekah and Makkedah. And as they fled before Israel, while they were going down the ascent of Beth-horon, the **Lord** threw down large stones from heaven on them as far as Azekah, and they died. There were more who died because of the hailstones than the sons of Israel killed with the sword.”

OBEDIENTLY ELIMINATING IDOLATRY

And they struck with the sword all who were in it, **devoting them to destruction**; there was **none left that breathed**. And he burned Hazor with fire. And all the cities of those kings, and all their kings, Joshua captured, and struck them with the edge of the sword, **devoting them to destruction**, just as Moses the servant of the Lord had **commanded**. But none of the cities that stood on mounds did Israel burn, except Hazor alone; that Joshua burned. And all the spoil of these cities and the livestock, the people of Israel took for their plunder. But every person they struck with the edge of the sword until they had destroyed them, and they did **not leave any who breathed**. Just as the Lord had **commanded** Moses his servant, so Moses **commanded** Joshua, and so Joshua did. He left nothing undone of all that the Lord had **commanded** Moses.



THE ALLEGATION: REBELS BREAKING FAITH

“Thus says the whole congregation of the Lord, ‘What is this **breach of faith** that you have committed against the God of Israel in turning away this day from following the Lord by **building yourselves an altar** this day in **rebellion** against the Lord? Have we not had enough of the sin at Peor from which even yet we have not cleansed ourselves, and for which there came a plague upon the congregation of the Lord, that you too must turn away this day from following the Lord? And if you too **rebel** against the Lord today then tomorrow he will be angry with the whole congregation of Israel. But now, if the land of your possession is unclean, pass over into the Lord's land where the Lord's tabernacle stands, and take for yourselves a possession among us. Only do not **rebel** against the Lord or make us as **rebels** by **building for yourselves an altar** other than the altar of the Lord our God. Did not Achan the son of Zerah **break faith** in the matter of the devoted things, and wrath fell upon all the congregation of Israel? And he did not perish alone for his iniquity.’”

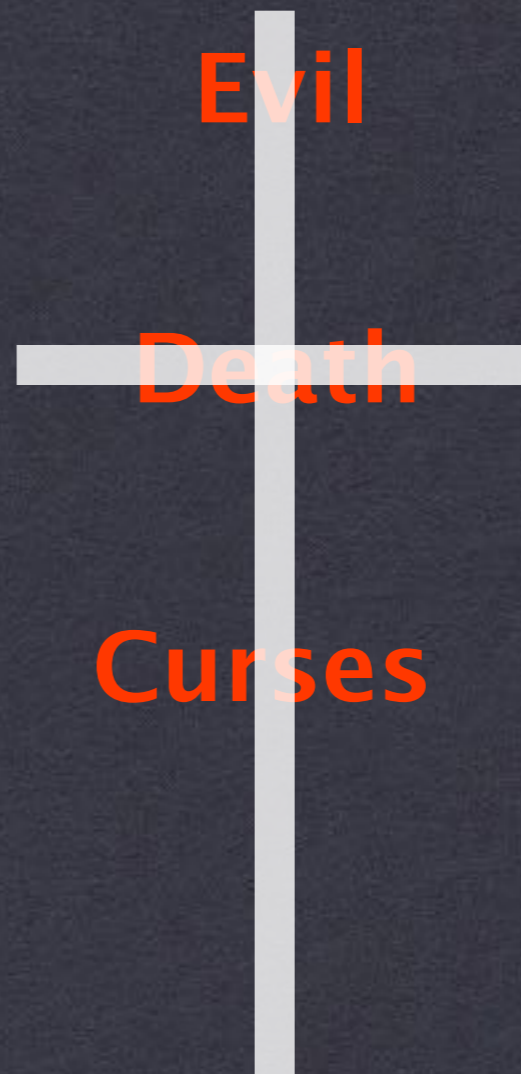
