

Art in the Auditorium

Each year, up to five exhibits of two months duration incorporate the visual arts into the worship life of PBCC. Each exhibit has a theme, chosen to glorify the Lord and expand the Church members' understanding of Biblical truth, leading them to a richer relationship with the Lord and to experience the joy, wonder, and mystery of our Creator. Planned and curated by the Visual Arts Ministry leadership, the yearly calendar includes invitational exhibits of one to four artists, and non-juried open call exhibits to which all members of the PBCC community are invited to submit art. These exhibits provide our artists and craftspeople opportunities to produce art which overtly responds to God and the Christian faith and to use their work in the teaching, encouraging and worship ministries of our Body. Previous exhibit themes have included: *New Life in Christ, Window into the Psalms, The Gospel of Luke and Our Favorite Bible Stories (PBCC 3RD - 8TH Graders)*. Announcements of an Open Call for Art for an upcoming group exhibit are placed in PBCC Sunday Worship Guides and weekly PBCC eBulletins.
