The fine art and craft workshops offered at PBCC are designed to encourage and equip our Body to serve the Lord through the visual arts. Most of the workshops are appropriate for a wide range of previous experience and skills in the art or craft being presented; folks who have done little or nothing in the visual arts are encouraged to participate. The emphasis is on having a good time exploring the visual arts in the company of others doing the same.

Workshops are usually scheduled for the third Sunday of each month, from 1:00 – 4:00 pm. All ages from 8 years old through adults, from both PBCC and the larger community, are invited. Children from age 8 to middle school must be accompanied by a supervising adult; not recommended for children under age 8.
