2. Discussion Questions

a. Preparation Questions:

1. What points from Ryan's sermon gave you hope?
2. In Ryan's intro he mentioned how it can be challenging culturally to confess our need for Christ (our refuge). Do you feel you can with each other (discuss the "ruins" in your life)?

b. Sermon Questions

1. In Chapter 20 the concept of refuge in the Jewish judicial system for manslaughter and strangers (accidental death) is highlighted.
 - a. How did the parallel of Christ today that Ryan made strike you?
 - b. What does this represent for us in our walk with Lord and each other?
2. In Chapter 21 and the Levites provision is discussed in detail.
 - a. Why in the map Ryan showed were the sites spread out?
 - b. What service were the Levi priests providing?
 - c. To give up part of the pasture lands and inheritance was a big deal at this time. How did you react to the parallel idea of our tithe today? How do you view your giving today?
3. Ryan summarized these texts with the comment that God had finally brought order to the Jews journey and it's symbolism of returning to the creation narrative. How did you respond to his comment that today the Spirit brings order to our world through the Spirit?

c. For Further Reflection:

1. In the closing song there is reference to God "never letting me down." Do you feel this to be true in your life based on your circumstances?
2. What promises of God can you count on? What does God's faithfulness mean to you?
