Matthew 7:13-29—The Great Divide

Context:

The Sermon on the Mount concludes this week with the ultimate question and challenge for our lives. Jesus does not end with the Golden Rule but a choice. Do we listen only or do we act as well?

Questions:

1. How did you respond to the quiet time at the end of sermon to reflect on the Sermon on the Mount?
2. Verse 14—the concept of true life is brought up in this verse.
 - a. How do you view your walk with the Lord and following Him and His path as giving you life?
 - b. What happens when we lose sight of this?
3. Verse 21—What is the will of God in this context?
4. Verse 22—Some of the fruit listed is a bit head scratching that God would not be present in the fruit—how can this be?
5. Verse 29—What is different between Jesus authority and the scribes?
 - a. How does this principle change your view of listening and obeying God?
 - b. How does Jesus authority give **you hope**?
