The Gospel of John

PBCC Pastor Shawn Reese describes the Gospel of John as the most unique of the four Gospels. Shawn began teaching from this Gospel in January of 2020, continuing through the book in two installments each year since. He resumes his sermon series this year in March and again in the Fall. Everyone – child, youth, or adult – is invited to submit art inspired by this unique Gospel for an exhibit scheduled to accompany Shawn's return to the Gospel of John in September.

This exhibit will include the entire Book of John, including those chapters Shawn has not covered by the beginning of his Fall teaching. A page of resources is included with this Call.

Artwork: All 2-D and 3-D works are welcome, including drawings, paintings, prints, photographs, mixed media, collage, quilts, needlework, sculpture, wood carving.... Wall art must be no larger than 72"Hx48"Wx4"D, and appropriately framed and ready to hang with hooks mounted on the top 2 back corners; please do not use saw teeth. Attach a label to the back of the work with your name and title of the art. Artists wishing to submit free-standing 3-D work are advised to consult with the curators in advance as PBCC has limited spaces appropriate for the display of such work. This is not a juried exhibit, but the Arts in the Auditorium curators and supervising pastors reserve the right to refuse any work they deem inappropriate for our Worship setting. Each artist may submit a maximum of 3 works. Work that has been previously exhibited at PBCC will not be accepted.

Artist Statement: With each work submit a statement of 150 WORDS OR LESS, that explains how that piece of art relates to the theme, and if you had any Biblical passages in mind as you created it, please include the verse.

Sales: Indicate if your work is for sale or not. The Brochure accompanying the Exhibit will identify those that are not for sale and state the price of those that are. Interested buyers will be directed to contact the artist directly at the artist's email address and/or phone number listed in the brochure. No commission will be charged on sales occurring during the exhibit, but a donation to PBCC is suggested.

Sermons Relating to the Gospel of John presented at PBCC

The Gospel of John is a rich source of inspiration for artists. It contains many stories ripe for illustration including Jesus' miraculous feeding of the 5000 and his walking on water. The picturesque metaphors that answer the question, "Who is this Jesus?", beg to be made visible by the artist's imagination and hand. Let your imagination play as you explore this unique Gospel and create art that shares with us your response to it.
