The Good News

"The angel said, 'I bring you Good News...Today a savior has been born; he is the Messiah, the Lord.'"

Luke 2:10-11

Advent season prepares us to celebrate the birth of the Savior for all mankind, the Lord Jesus Christ. The Good News, or Gospel, says that Jesus's life, death, and resurrection made salvation and freedom from sin and its condemnation available to everyone who believes in Him. The entire Bible proclaims this message, answering the questions, "What is the Gospel?" and "How does it affect peoples' lives?" For this year's Advent/Christmas Exhibit, create and submit art that addresses these questions. A more detailed discussion of this theme, and suggestions and references to help you in your exploration of this theme are provided with this Call.

Artwork: All 2-D and 3-D works are welcome, including drawings, paintings, prints, photographs, mixed media, collage, quilts, needlework, sculpture, wood carving.... Wall art must be no larger than 72"H x 48"W x 4"D, and appropriately framed and ready to hang with hooks mounted on the back, 2" from the top; please do not use saw teeth. Attach a label to the back of the work with your name and title of the art. Artists wishing to submit free-standing 3-D work are advised to consult with the curators in advance as PBCC has limited spaces appropriate for the display of such work. This is not a juried exhibit, but the Arts in the Auditorium curators and supervising pastors reserve the right to refuse any work they deem inappropriate for our Worship setting. Each artist may submit a maximum of 3 works. Work that has been previously exhibited at PBCC will not be accepted.

Artist Statement: With each work submit a statement of 150 WORDS OR LESS, that explains how that piece of art relates to the theme, and if you had any Biblical passages in mind as you created it, please include the verses.

Sales: Indicate if your work is for sale or not. The Brochure accompanying the Exhibit will identify those that are not for sale and state the price of those that are. Interested buyers will be directed to contact the artist directly at the artist's email address and/or phone number listed in the brochure. No commission will be charged on sales occurring during the exhibit, but a donation to PBCC is suggested.
