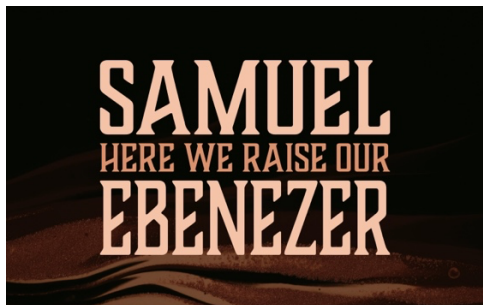


“Second Person Plural”
